Subject: Intimation about Revised Guidelines for the Release of Funds towards Institutes/Universities - reg.

This is to bring to the kind notice of the Registrar, University of Kashmir, that the Department of Space (DoS), Government of India has come up with a set of revised guidelines on Grant-in-Aids vide order number DS_2B-13/1/2017-Sec.2, dated June 20, 2022.

According to the revised guidelines for sanctioning of the Grant-in-Aids, the following may kindly be noted:

For new projects:

"The deliverables shall be clearly defined for each year in terms of objective output indicators in the proposals"

For ongoing projects:

"While submitting proposals for release of grants in subsequent years, progress/completion of deliverables defined for previous year including publications planned, equipment/software procured etc., shall be made available."

In order to comply with the above, a template is attached to submit a report on the achievements of the project for the reporting year, which will be assessed for the sanctioning of funds for the subsequent year.

For all (new and ongoing) projects:

1. "Amount related to contingencies and institute overheads shall be released only after submission of closure report to the concerned authorities and acceptance of the same by the Programme Office."

Forwarded to Registrar.

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
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2. "IP generated as part of project completion shall be jointly owned by ISRO and it shall be the responsibility of Co-PI to ensure hand over of the same to concerned entity in ISRO."
3. "A minimum of two peer-reviewed publications would be expected during project period."
4. "Potential for patent shall also be actively explored."

In view of the above, Registrar, University of Kashmir, may kindly intimate the HODs and Principal Investigator/s of the ISRO/DoS funded projects to kindly note and follow the above-mentioned guidelines.
