Greetings from the MoE's Innovation Cell !!!

Hope your NISP institute is participating in ARIIA 2022. visit [www.ariaa.gov.in](http://www.ariaa.gov.in) for more detail about ARIIA. If your institute is participating in ARIIA 2022, then the following points are required to keep in mind.

The submission deadline for the Section 7.3 (Patents Published and Granted during the Annual Calendar year 2020 and 2021), & the final submission of the application for ARIIA 2022 is now 7th Nov 2022.

If your institute has already submitted the ARIIA application and updated the 7.3 section, and found no issues regarding auto-pooling and reflection in the ARIIA report, then please ignore this reminder email.

It is found that many institutions are still having some technical difficulties and queries related to section 7.3 and the reflection of data of YUKTI in ARIIA DCS. Therefore the ARIIA portal will accept submissions for both section 7.3 and the final submission of the application till 7th Nov 2022.

- Submission of data in the Pre-qualifier section is optional and can be skipped.
- For section 7.3 (Patents Published and Granted during the Annual Calendar year 2020 and 2021), now the institute can do additions/corrections multiple times even after it checked I CONFIRM and clicked the SUBMIT button. This functionality will remain open till the last date of the portal and submitted entry items will automatically get reflected in the ARIIA report.
- If the institute has already taken action in the NISP portal and if it is showing PENDING there in the NISP portal, then needn't worry. You can go ahead with the submission of the ARIIA application. The updated status will auto-reflect in the ARIIA portal after verification of the same by MIC.
- Crosscheck the AISHE code used in the ARIIA, IIC, NISP, and KAPILA etc. It should be exactly the same and looks in the format of C-XXX. In case there is a mismatch, please update the same with the correct AISHE code on the welcome page of ARIIA. It is an essential condition for the auto-reflection of data in various sections.
- We observed that there are institutions that have not yet started YUKTI NIR. Institutes should scout, and build an innovation repository at the institute level by sharing the YUKTI link (provided in the IIC -YUKTI tab) with innovators, and entrepreneurs to register and login to submit their ideas, innovations and startups. Institutions should not create a login and enter data on behalf of innovators or entrepreneurs.
- Institutions should undertake verification of submitted applications by engaging in-house trained faculties as Innovation Ambassadors and (or) external experts as verifiers to verify the submitted application and remove the junk entries. Institute can manage this in the "Add Verifier" tab on the YUKTI-NIR page. Please note that only verified and recommended innovations and start-ups ( not ideas) for the financial year 2020-21, and 2021-22 as listed in YUKTI will be auto-pooled and reflected in the ARIIA DCS.
- Don't upload or submit junk and irrelevant entries in sections 2.1, 2.2, 3, 6, 7.1, 7.2, 7.3, and 7.4. Please cross-check these sections if you have not yet submitted the final application. There will be a penalty score for submitting irrelevant and junk entries.

ARIIA nodal officers may join the telegram group of ARIIA by using the link placed on the login page of ARIIA to get quick information about ARIIA.
