

We invite young people of all nationalities from all over the world aged 16 to 30 years to participate in the competition of scientific and sci-fi works about the image of the future.







CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION:

- The Competition is open to graduate students, young professionals, students and schoolchildren of any nationality from any country of the world, carrying out scientific research, scientific and practical (applied) activities and / or science fiction literary creativity in the subject area of the Competition.
- Applications for participation are accepted in the form of:
 - science fiction work (story, essay, reportage): strictly individual work;
 - scientific work (article, research, scientific and practical work): individual work or work as part of a team of authors of up to three people
- Age of participants: 16 30 years.
- Each participant of the Competition, taking into account all nominations, can submit no more than one individual application or be a participant in no more than one application from the project team / team of authors.
- Laureates of the Competition 2019 2022 are allowed to participate in the Competition only with new works and as part of new project teams or teams of authors.

FINAL EVENTS FOR THE WINNERS:

- 1. In January 2024, the winners of the competition (I, II, III places) will take part in the online School of Future Skills;
- 2. Luncheons will be invited to the International Youth Foresight Forum "Sustainable Development 2100: Forecasts, Vision, Scenarios and Plans" (February 5-7, 2024), at one of the selected sites:
- in Moscow, Russia (working language Russian),
- or in Cuenca, Ecuador (working language is Spanish),
- or in Delhi, India (working language is English),
- or to Cairo, Egypt (working language Arabic and/or English),

During the Forum, the winners will receive: strategic sessions, team project work, an award ceremony for the winners of the competition - awarding Diplomas, announcing and awarding the winners of the Grand Prix of the Competition in each of the two categories.

- 3. Members of the best teams that took 1st, 2nd, 3rd places at each forum will take part in the Global Youth Team Science Battle "HORIZON 2100", where the GRAND PRIX team will be determined.
- 4. In June 2024, the best of the best will be invited to St. Petersburg, Russia, for the Scientific and Practical Foresight Conference "Russia and the World by 2100: New Challenges, New Solutions", which will be held on the sidelines of SPIEF'24.

World Youth Festival 2024

The World Youth Festival will be held in 2024 to develop international youth cooperation.

Festival motto: Let's start the future together!

The Festival program is structured around a set of universal values. We invite youth from all over the world to reflect on these values together and exchange ideas on how to build a future world that is comfortable for everybody. It includes not only discussions and lectures but also an exhibition program, cultural exchange, sports competitions and group workouts, volunteering activities, and group trips.

The Festival is inspired by the traditions of youth and student festivals, which were organized several times in our country - in 1957 and 1985, bringing together tens of thousands of participants from all over the world. In its contemporary history, Russia hosted the festival in 2017.

The World Youth Festival will be attended by 20,000 young leaders in such fields as business, media, education, science, international cooperation, culture, volunteering and charity, sports, and others, including 10,000 foreign participants. For the first time in the history of the festival movement, teenagers from 14 to 17 years old will have the opportunity to join the event, including 500 from Russia and 500 from abroad.

5,000 volunteers from all regions of Russia will be involved in organizing the Festival.

The main program of the Festival for all participants will be held on the Sirius Federal Territory from March 1 to March 7, 2024.

The regional program will be held from March 10 to March 17, 2024, with foreign participants visiting 26 Russian cities.

Primary focus areas of the WYF 2024:

IT, science, media, tourism, environmental science, entrepreneurship, volunteering, sports, culture, politics, education, urban planning, agriculture, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), working youth, diplomacy, and engineering.

WYF objectives:

Our main goal is to create long-term relationships between active young people from all over the world who will have to build a common future together - a just, multipolar world based on cooperation and the search for a balance of interests.

During various team activities, young people will connect, communicate, seek common ground, and learn to interact with each other.

The Festival also seeks to introduce Russian and international youth to the vast range of opportunities our country has to offer.

We will be sharing the finest aspects of Russian values and culture and, at the same time, learning about the interests and aspirations of the youth from other countries.

Registration of participants:

Registration for both international and Russian youth is taking place on the official WYF 2024 website at https://fest2024.com. Individuals between the ages of 18 and 35, as well as teenagers aged 14 to 17, regardless of their country of residence, can apply.

Foreign participants can submit their applications until December 1, while registration for Russian participants will be open until November 4, 2023.



ABOUT THE WORLD YOUTH FESTIVAL 2024

The World Youth Festival (hereafter referred to as the "Festival") will take place in **Sochi, Russia**, from **March 1**st **to March 7**th, **2024**. The event is organized under Decree № 249 "On holding the World Youth Festival in 2024", signed by the President of the Russian Federation on April 5th, 2023.

It is not the first time in Russia's recent history that the country becomes a world center for uniting young people striving to develop genuinely friendly relations based on equality, mutual respect and responsibility for our shared future. It is also worth noting that the opening date of the Festival coincides with the 10th anniversary of the end of the Winter Olympic Games in Sochi in 2014, and the Olympic Park will serve as the primary venue.

The Festival aims to unite the most progressive young people on the planet who are concerned about our shared future. This goal will be achieved through a series of scientific and educational activities, along with open discussions. These will allow the participants to address key youth development issues pertinent to the transition towards a more just, democratic and multipolar world order.

The event will bring together **young leaders and specialists** representing fields such as international relations, entrepreneurship, science, culture, sports, media, charity and volunteering from more than 180 countries. The participants' age range is from **18 to 35 years old**. A total of **20,000 participants**, 10,000 from Russia and 10,000 from abroad, will attend the event after having passed a competitive selection process. The Festival will foster a collective vision for the future development of youth.

The Festival agenda includes discussions, educational, cultural and sports programs. These aim to consolidate global youth around the idea of justice and strengthen its role in the evolving system of international relations. All activities will consider the participants' geographical background and address the development



issues of various regions of the world (Americas, Middle East, Africa, Europe, Asia and Oceania).

The organizing committee puts special effort into the preparation of the discussion platform. There, participants will be able to exchange views on topical issues with their peers and invited speakers in the format of panel discussions, round tables and workshops. These issues include the current international agenda, as well as prospects for the youth movement developing in different regions of the world.

The cultural program is designed to educate the participants about the history, culture and traditions of Russia and other countries. The sports program will allow the participants to demonstrate their physical fitness and engage in a range of leisure activities.

The 6 official languages of the UN (Russian, English, Arabic, Spanish, Chinese and French) have been chosen as the working languages of the Festival.

The key events will take place on the Sirius Federal Territory (Sochi Olympic Park)—a cultural, scientific, educational and sports hub of the region. All facilities were built specifically for the XXII Olympic Winter Games and the 2014 XI Winter Paralympics. The infrastructure is based on a "15-minute city" concept: all venues and amenities, including hotels, recreation facilities, sports arenas, and event and lecture halls, are located within walking distance from each other making navigation easy and convenient. Participants will also be able to enjoy various types of cultural and leisure activities across the city of Sochi.

Selected members of foreign delegations will have the opportunity to partake in the regional program and travel to one of the Russian cities after the main Festival program ends.

A total of **5,000 volunteers** over the age of 18 will help coordinate the event. They will undergo training in 20 certified volunteer centers.
