SUB: The Fee structure for All India Quota (AIQ) – Under Graduate and Post Graduate seats of ASU & H courses should be at par with State Quota seats for the A.Y. 2023-24 and onwards -reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter dated 15.11.2022, wherein it has been directed to all State/UT Govt./Participating Institutes to ensure the fee structure for All India Quota UG&PG seats should not be higher than the State Quota seats for the A.Y 2022-23.

- In this Academic session also, it has been observed that certain colleges have filled their seat matrix with the higher fee structure for AIQ seats than State Quota seats.
- 3. In this regard, it is pertinent to mention that the AIQ Scheme is introduced to provide domicile-free, merit-based opportunities to students from any State/UT, to study in reputed Govt./Govt Aided ASU&H Medical institutions in any other state and to facilitate students of all socio-economic section of the country shall be eligible for higher education.
- 4. Therefore, it is requested that all State/UT Government/Participating ASU & H Institutes to ensure the Fee structure for All India Quota Undergraduate and Postgraduate seats of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU&H) courses should be at par with State Quota seats for the A.Y 2023-24 and onwards.
