“National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students” has 2 components :

- **Fellowship Scholarship**
- **National Top Class Scholarship**

Features

Fellowship: 750 ST Students/year for pursuing regular M. Phil and Ph. D. Courses.

Scholarship: To pursue courses at Graduate/Post Graduate level in 246 Institutions of excellence, in professional fields such as Management, Medicine, Engineering, Information Technology, Law etc.

“National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students”

Objective: The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the Scheduled tribe students to enable them to pursue higher education after completing Post Graduate level so as:

- To increase the spread of higher education among ST students.
- To encourage meritorious students to pursue higher studies to enable them to become role model of the community as well as to increase their employability potential.
- To enable these students to contribute to national economy by ensuring their potential employability as well as to enable them to contribute towards the society.
- Helps in promoting Inclusive Education among Scheduled Tribes

Fellowship under the Scheme will be for pursuing MPhil, Ph.D by those ST students who have passed the Post-graduation/Master Degree examination.

Note: - In case, under the national education policy, there is any change in the type of course, the same will be incorporated in the guidelines. However, the scholars already covered under the scheme prior to 2021-22, will be allowed to complete the course as per the existing scheme.

Eligibility

Parameters	Details
Admission	students can take admission for regular and full time M. Phil/Ph.D courses in the following categories of University / Academic Institutes: i. Universities/Institutes/Colleges included under section 2(f)/12(B) or 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act. ii. Deemed to be Universities included under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 and eligible to receive grant-in-aid from UGC. iii. Universities/ Institutes/ Colleges receiving grants by Central/ State Government iv. Institutes of National Importance, as notified by Ministry of Higher Education, Government of India.
Marks	55% of marks in post-graduation
Age	Maximum 36 years, as on first day of July of the selection year

Note-1 :- Eligible students who have got offer of admission in **IITs/AIIMS/IIMs/IISER** will be given priority and slots meant for ST-General (Sr.No.4 above) will be reduced proportionately.

Note-2:- The students applying as Divyangjan should produce the Disability Certificate, certifying **minimum 40%** disability, issued by the competent authority designated by respective State/UT.

Step 1: Registration Process: New user is required to register first time with valid ID card issued by the University/Institute. There may be **More than one user** also can register him/her self with a valid mail id and mobile no for one Institute/University.

1. Nodal Officer [Nominated by the Univerisity]
2. Verification Officer [Actual technical /authorized person who is handling portal for dealing with verification student details, uploading certificates etc.] who is appointed and authorized by the University/Institute.

Required Documents (For Registration) :

1. ID of the concerned Officer issued by the University along with authorization letter
[University/Institute should authorize the Nodal Officer, verification officer. The authorization should in the official letter head of the University/Institute containing the Name, e-mail Id and Contact Number of Nodal Officer, verification officer. The authorization letter should be uploaded for creation of user-id.]
2. University/Institute should upload the document as applicable from the following category:
 - I. Universities/institutions/Colleges included under section 2(f)or12(B)or2(f)and12(B)of UGC Act.
 - II. Deemed to be Universities included under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 and eligible to receive grants-in-aid from UGC.
 - III. Universities/ Institutions/ Colleges funded by Central/ State Government
 - IV. Institutes of National importance.

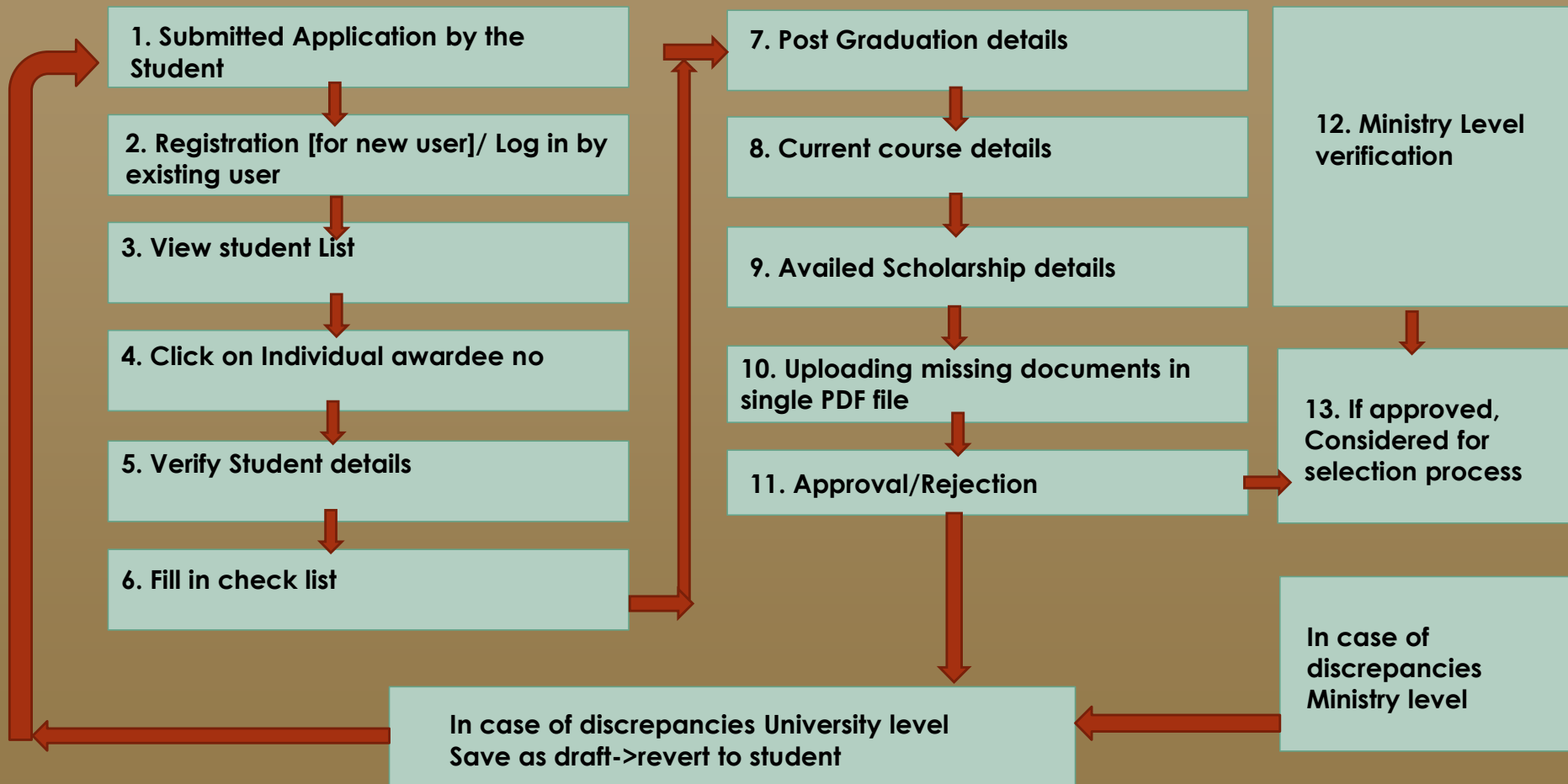

- ST Certificate [community name should match with the names mentioned under resource section of <https://fellowship.tribal.gov.in/>]
 - Caste certificate is issued by the competent authority [should not be below rank of Tehsildar]
- Date of Birth Certificate [Matriculation/School Leaving Certificate]
- All Year/Semester Marksheet of Post Graduation. [For Aggregate Percentage] (M.Phil. or Pre Ph.D. marks will not be considered as Masters' Degree)
- Conversion factor formulae provided by Concern University (from where the candidate completed his/her Post-Graduation, Grade to Percentage.) [Only for those whose Marks in Grade System like, CGPA/OGPA.]
- PVTG [Only Applicable when the applicant is belongs to PVTG Category] : [community name should match with the names mentioned under resource section of <https://fellowship.tribal.gov.in/>]
- Divyangjan Certificate [Only Applicable when the applicant is a Divangjan]
- Valid Document for University Registration/ Admission
- Income Certificate [Not Mandatory , Do not Reject any candidate for Income Criteria/certificate]

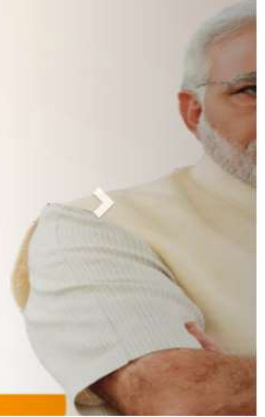
