SRO 129 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000, the Government hereby exempts from payment of entry tax, leviable under the Act, the Scientific equipment, critical chemicals and reagents, used by the research and development institutions of the Central or the State Government, functioning within the State, subject to the condition that the Head of such institution shall issue a certificate with regard to the requirement of such items, giving full particulars of the importer as well as the supplier, the specifications, quantity and value of such equipment/chemicals/reagents to be imported, which shall be made available, in original, to the incharge of the notified Commercial Taxes check post , through which the import is being made.

This notification shall come into force w.e.f 01.04.2012.
